### Rules

- Each team chooses one main dish to cook – no appetizers or desserts. (We would like to have a variety of dishes for our patrons, so please let us know within a few days of signing up what dish you wish to cook so that we can avoid too many of the same dish.)
- Contest will be located at Living Word Church.
- A \$25.00 nonrefundable entry fee is required.
- Each team pays for the ingredients and materials to cook their dish. Teams are ENCOURAGED to secure sponsors and may display that sponsor's name(s) at their tent using banners or signs or tents bearing the sponsor's name.

### Cooking Rules

- Meal MUST be ready to serve at 11:30am.
- Cooking can take place at home or on-site. (Please ensure all foods are cooked to proper temperature and transported with food safety in mind. Please ensure proper sanitary conditions are maintained throughout the cooking and serving process.)
- Each team needs to provide food for 250 – 3-ounce servings. This would equal about 50 full-size servings. **It is VERY IMPORTANT that you do not run out of food.** Plan for EXTRA to be sure!
- Houma Pumpkin Patch & Living Word Church will provide serving bowls and utensils for patrons.

### What To Bring

- Each team needs to provide a 10 x 10 tent, table(s), and chairs for teammates.
- If cooking on site, teams must provide cooking stove, fuel/propane, cooking pot, serving spoons, cutting board, knife, water, cooler (for meat and perishables), paper towels, can opener *and whatever it takes to cook your meal.*

### Judging Criteria

- Each person who purchases a Cook Off food card will get one ticket for voting in the Cook Off. After sampling, patrons will place tickets into the jar at the booth of their favorite dish. The team with the most tickets at 1:00pm will be the winner.
- Ticket collection ends at 1:00pm, with winner announced at 1:30pm.
- The winning team gets to donate \$250 to their favorite nonprofit organization.
